STEARNS, D.J.

The motion of defendants Raytheon Company, Ian C. Mitchell, and Arthur Buliung is ALLOWED in part. Plaintiff Yong Li is ordered to appear at a deposition at a date, time, and place reasonably noticed by the defendants, in any event no later than twenty-one (21) days of the date of this Order. Yong Li will fully cooperate, without conditions (other than the good faith assertion of privilege), by attending the deposition and answering questions, or her case will be dismissed with prejudice. Also, pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 37(a)(4)(A), the court orders Yong Li to pay \$750 to defendants as reasonable compensation for the costs and attorneys' fees incurred in bringing the motion to compel.
